## Outpatient Clinic Making Impact

According to an April 2017 [cbsnews.com](http://cbsnews.com) headline, the “Heroin epidemic kills at least 23 Ohioans each week.”

In just 6 months, the number of clients served through our outpatient clinic has tripled. Our community needs addiction treatment services. CND offers assessment, individual and group counseling, case management, and medically assisted treatment. CND takes most major insurances, including Medicaid, and self pay.

Recovery is possible. Our locations on the near east side of Columbus are discrete, and on the bus line, allowing for peace of mind for clients to receive treatment. We are also open Monday-Saturday, with morning and evening times.
